The Governor's Advisory Council for Exceptional Citizens (GACEC) has reviewed the Division of Medicaid and Medicare Assistance (DMMA) proposal to expand vision services available to a subset of Delaware Healthy Children Program (DHCP) beneficiaries. Under the current proposal, DMMA would contract with a non-profit Medicaid provider to offer free eye exams and glasses on site at Title I Delaware schools in which at least 51% of the student body receives free or reduced price meals. At 611. The GACEC **endorses** the proposed coverage since vision services would benefit low-income children and the proposal leverages significant federal funding.
