The Governor's Advisory Council for Exceptional Citizens (GACEC) has reviewed the Division of Public Health (DPH) proposal to adopt a brief amendment to its regulations covering Delaware Medical Orders for Scope of Treatment (DMOST). Section 2.1.1 would be amended to clarify that the identification section of the DMOST form must include the address of record, phone number and gender of the patient. The actual form already includes these fields but the regulation did not require their inclusion. Council **endorses** the proposed amendment as it is essentially a housekeeping initiative.
